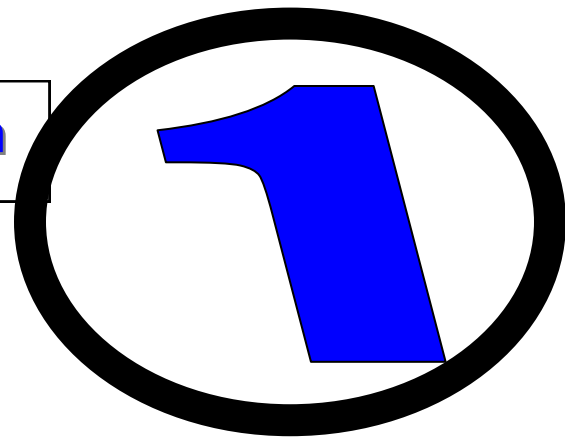

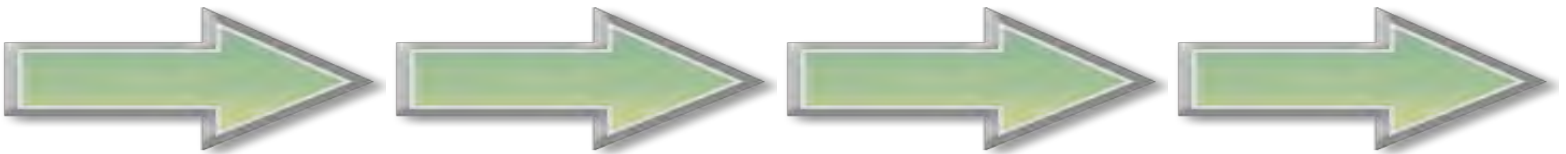

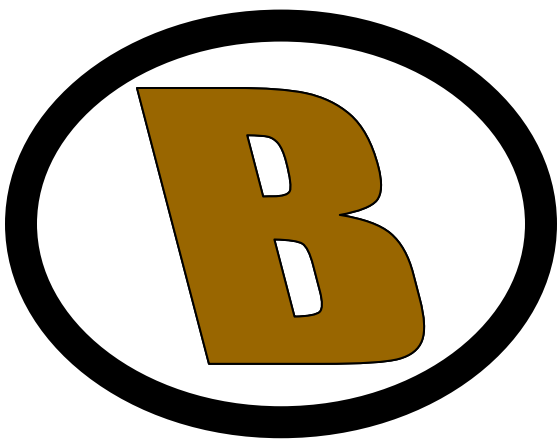
How much of this will I need to learn?

We hope you will want to learn all levels of this plan. Pray and ask God what you should do.



And if I do learn it, what then?

At the end of April, we will have the Children's Scripture Memory Banquet for each child and their family who completes each level. At that time, each child who has completed the Bronze Medal Level, Silver Medal Level, and the Gold Medal Level will be awarded their bronze, silver, or gold medals respectively.



BRONZE MEDAL

Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn eleven verses and also tell difference between the Old and New Testaments.

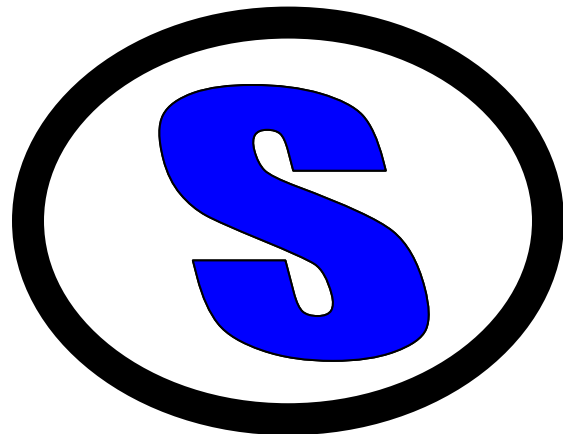
