REGULATIONS AGREEMENT FORM

ORIENTATION MEETING: Parents agree to attend the orientation meeting set for August 8 from 1:00-3:00 p.m. at Lakeview.

ATTENDANCE: Make class time a priority. LCS policy is no unexcused absences. The teacher must be notified of upcoming absence, work will still be due on due date either turned in by another student or arranging to carry the work to the teacher's home, and if necessary compensating the teacher for extra time outside the class to catch the student up on work.

MISSED WORK: It will be the responsibility of each student to find out what was missed and to keep current. A friend may take notes or pick up papers for the student. Any in class activities such as pop quizzes, tests, group activities, etc., must also be made up through consultation with the teacher. We encourage parents to stay in good communication with the teacher. Even if a student is absent the work is still due on the date assigned.

PARENTAL SUPERVISION OF COURSE WORK: Go over the class syllabus with the student making sure that they understand what is expected and when certain homework assignments are due. The teachers may have classroom specific expectations. Commit to looking over student's work and grades given each week.

PROGRESS REPORTS/GRADES: A progress report will be sent home mid semester. Semester grades will be given and a final year end grade will be given. The year end grades will be mailed to each student's home school covering administrator. If fees are still owed, grades will not be released. Parents are expected to accept the grade given by the teacher without alteration.

ON CAMPUS CONDUCT: Students will not arrive or remain more than 15 minutes before or after class starts. Students will not be allowed to roam the church building. Any student with more than 15 minutes wait time between classes will be required to go to Study Hall for a minimal charge of \$5.00 per month. No student may leave campus between back to back classes or during the break in the middle of class.

- Cell phone use is strictly restricted to out of class use.
- No boyfriend/girlfriend display of affection on campus.
- Classroom behavior should be above reproach – no talking, disobeying the class rules, being disrespectful of teacher or inappropriate language at the discretion of the teacher.
- Students should dress modestly and appropriately which means no sleepwear, no spaghetti straps, and no shorts for girls. Only long pants, capris, or skirts to the knees are allowed.

GROUND FOR DISMISSAL: Failure to adhere to the regulations outlined on this form constitutes grounds for dismissal. If your student knowingly submits plagiarized assigned work, he or she will fail the course.

WITHDRAWING: A student may be withdrawn without penalty provided that the student is withdrawn by the next class period after the midterm week. No record will appear on the permanent record. After the deadline however, the student will receive the designation – W/(grade) at time of withdrawal but no High School credit. To withdraw, the parent needs to submit in writing to the teacher a signed request that the student be dropped from class. The request to withdraw will then be forwarded to the student's cover school.

FEES: Tuition fees are due July 1st for 1st semester and Nov. 1st for 2nd semester with a \$25.00 increase per month per class after the deadline.

The registration fee is due at the time of registration with the registration form. All fees should be payable to Lakeview Christian School and registration and tuition fees may be combined in one check. All fees are non refundable once paid.
