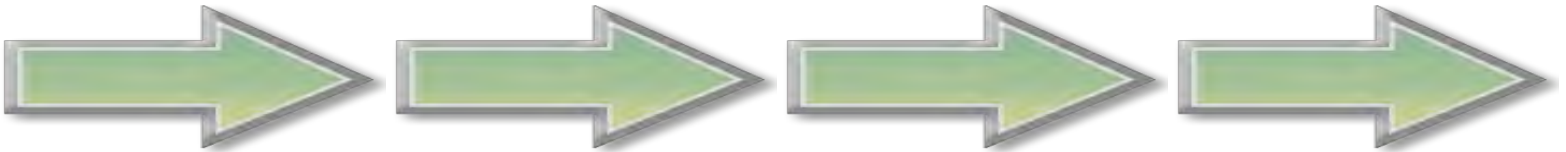

Reviewing each day will help your child memorize and retain scriptures for use in their daily life. Please help your child by explaining each verse. It will be an inspiration to your child when you learn the verses together.

This program does not replace the Sunday School Curriculum verses. (The New International Version of the Bible is used.)

No one will be called on to "recite" in front of a large group against his or her wishes.

As you progress from first grade through sixth grade in our church. Each year you will have a different Bible Memory Plan designed just for your grade.



## Important Questions



**Who will take part? When will we do all these things?**

Your Sunday School teachers encourage you in this program. You will learn some verses on Sunday mornings and you will need to study at home. You should ask Mom and Dad to help you learn— and to learn more verses with you! Your Sunday School Teachers will explain more.



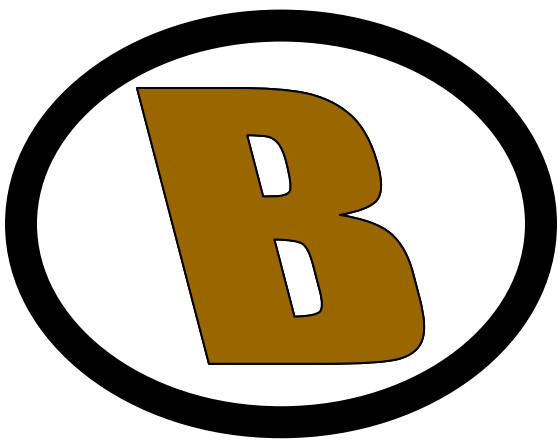
**How much of this will I need to learn?**

We hope you will want to learn all levels of this plan. Pray and ask God what you should do.



**And if I do learn it, what then?**

At the end of April, we will have the Children's Scripture Memory Banquet for each child and their family who completes each level. At that time, each child who has completed the Bronze Medal Level, Silver Medal Level, and the Gold Medal Level will be awarded their bronze, silver, or gold medals respectively.



## BRONZE MEDAL

Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn the Builder's Theme Verse, and eight verses on building our faith.

### BUILDER'S THEME VERSE

- Matthew 7:24 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock"

### BUILDING OUR FAITH

- Revelation 3:20 "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me."
- 1 Peter 2:5 "You also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house"
- 1 Corinthians 3:9 "For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building."

### BUILDING OUR FAITH ON GOD'S PROMISE

- 2 Corinthians 5:7 "We live by faith, not by sight."
- Acts 16:31 "They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."

### BUILDING OUR FAITH THROUGH GIVING

- Deuteronomy 16:17 "Each of you must bring a gift in proportion to the way the LORD your God has blessed you."
- Matthew 6:21 "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."
- Psalms 96:8 "Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; bring an offering and come into his courts."

## SILVER MEDAL

Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn the six verses on building love, and also a shortened form of the Ten Commandments.

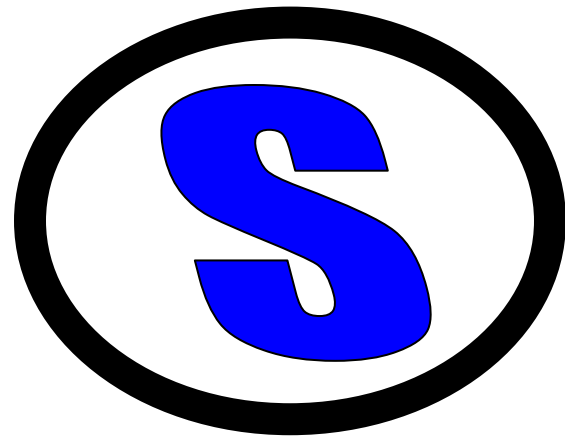
### BUILDING OUR LOVE

- Psalm 55:17 "Evening, morning and noon I cry out in distress, and he hears my voice."
- Philippians 4:13 "I can do everything through him who gives me strength."
- Luke 6:31 "Do to others as you would have them do to you."
- Ecclesiastes 9:10 "Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might"
- 2 Timothy 2:15 "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."
- Matthew 22:37-39 "Jesus replied: " 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

### TEN COMMANDMENTS

Exodus 20:3-4,7-8, 12-17
