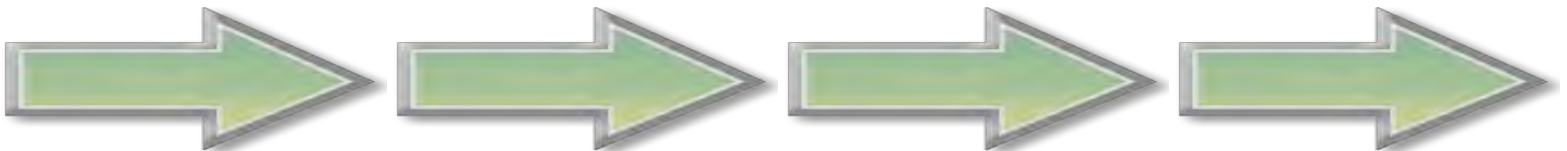

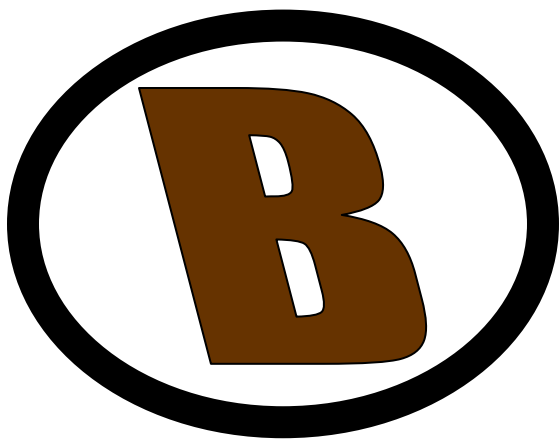
How much of this will I need to learn?

We hope you will want to learn all levels of this plan. Pray and ask God what you should do.



And if I do learn it, what then?

At the end of April, we will have the Children's Scripture Memory Banquet for each child and their family who completes each level. At that time, each child who has completed the Bronze Medal Level, Silver Medal Level, and the Gold Medal Level will be awarded their bronze, silver, or gold medals respectively.



BRONZE MEDAL

Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn the Harvester's Theme Verse, two verses on Jesus, two verses on service and worship and the names of all the books in the Bible.

HARVESTER'S THEME VERSE

- John 4:35 "I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest."

VERSES ON JESUS

- John 1:14 "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us."
- Luke 2:52 "And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men."

VERSES ON SERVICE AND WORSHIP

- Romans 12:1 "Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship."
- Acts 2:42 "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer."

○ VERSES ON SALVATION

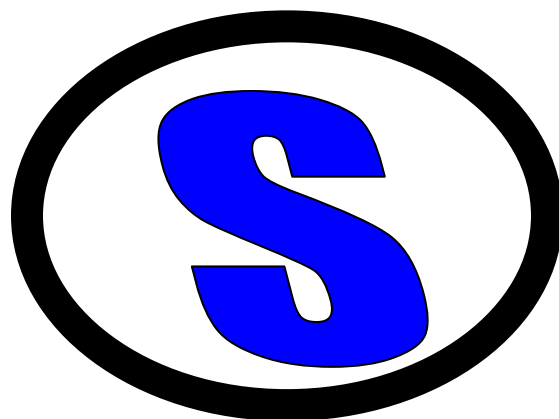
- Romans 10:9 "That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

○ VERSES ON LOVING GOD

- I John 4:11 "Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."
- Luke 11:28 "He replied, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it."
- Psalms 136:1 "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good. His love endures forever."

○ ADVICE FOR THE HARVESTER

- Galatians 6:7-10 "Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.
