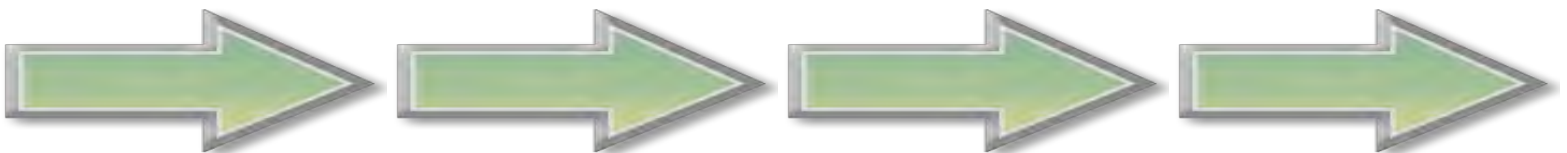

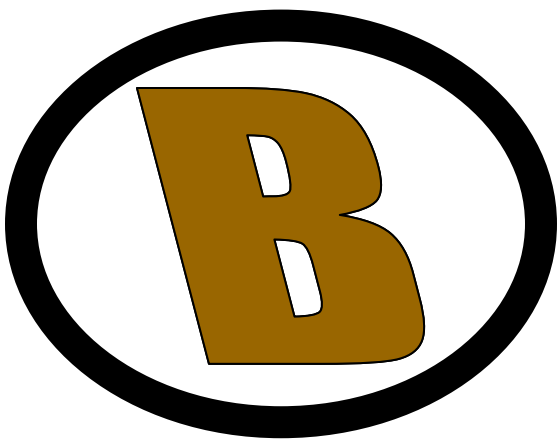
How much of this will I need to learn?

We hope you will want to learn all levels of this plan. Pray and ask God what you should do.



And if I do learn it, what then?

At the end of April, we will have the Children's Scripture Memory Banquet for each child and their family who completes each level. At that time, each child who has completed the Bronze Medal Level, Silver Medal Level, and the Gold Medal Level will be awarded their bronze, silver, or gold medals respectively.



BRONZE MEDAL

Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn the Disciple's Theme, names of the disciples, and the Roman Road.

THE DISCIPLE'S THEME

- Matthew 28:19-20 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

SILVER MEDAL

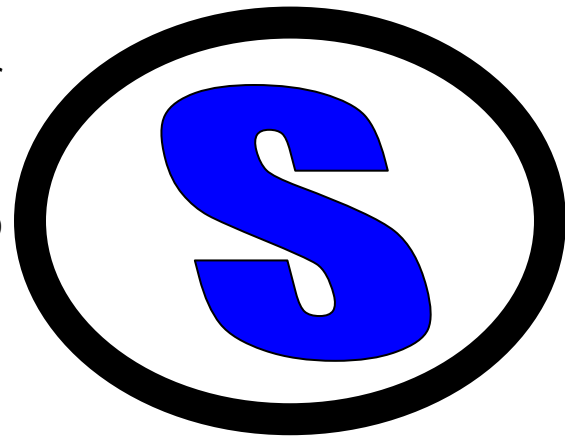
Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn sixteen verses.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISCIPLES

- Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight."
- Matthew 5:16 "In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven."
- Exodus 20:8 "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy."
- Malachi 3:10 "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the flood-gates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it."
- Philippians 4:4-7 "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

- Prepare a written paragraph on each of the twelve disciples.

○ The Disciple's Armor

- Ephesians 6:10-18 "Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions."
