As you progress from first grade through sixth grade in our church. Each year you will have a different Bible Memory Plan designed just for your grade. Engraved plaques are presented to six-year gold medalists.



## Important Questions

### **Who will take part? When will we do all these things?**

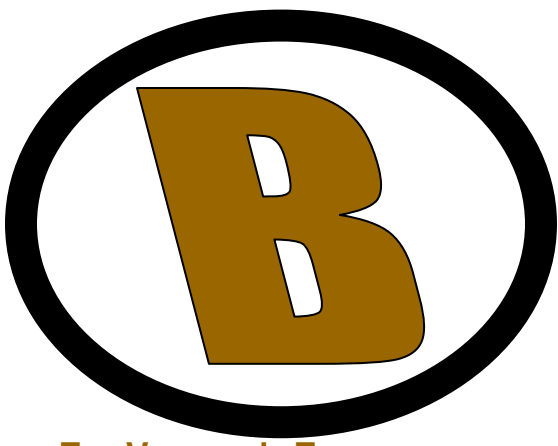
Your Sunday School teachers encourage you in this program. You will learn some verses on Sunday mornings and you will need to study at home. You should ask Mom and Dad to help you learn— and to learn more verses with you! Your Sunday School Teachers will explain more.

### **How much of this will I need to learn?**

We hope you will want to learn all levels of this plan. Pray and ask God what you should do.

### **And if I do learn it, what then?**

At the end of April, we will have the Children's Scripture Memory Banquet for each child and their family who completes each level. At that time, each child who has completed the Bronze Medal Level, Silver Medal Level, and the Gold Medal Level will be awarded their bronze, silver, or gold medals respectively.



## BRONZE MEDAL

Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn the Voyager's Theme, the Beatitudes, and two verses on salvation.

### ○ THE VOYAGER'S THEME

- Hebrews 12:1-2 "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

### ○ THE BEATITUDES

- Mathew 5:3-12

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.

Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

### ○ VERSES ON SALVATION

Luke 13:3 "I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish"

Isaiah 53:6 "We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all."

**SILVER MEDAL**

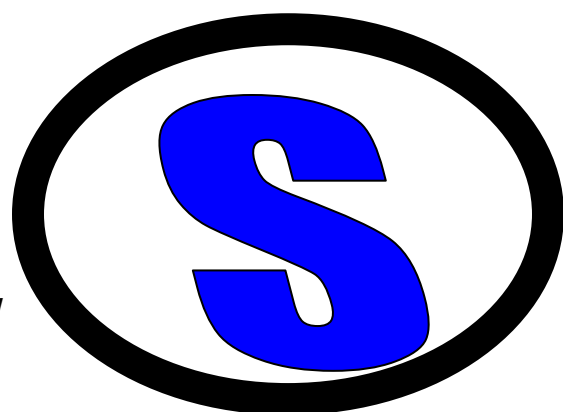
Each group of verses should be learned as a unit and repeated for the Sunday School teacher as a titled unit. In this level you must learn sixteen verses.

○ **VERSES ON BEING RIGHT WITH GOD**

- 1 John 1:9 “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.”
- 1 John 3:22 “And receive from him anything we ask, because we obey his commands and do what pleases him.”
- Psalms 51:10 “Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.”
- Psalms 19:14 “May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer.”

○ **PSALM 121**

I lift up my eyes to the hills— where does my help come from?  
My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth.  
He will not let your foot slip— he who watches over you will not slumber;  
indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.  
The Lord watches over you— the Lord is your shade at

## ○ The Love Chapter

1 Corinthians 13 “ If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a re-sounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing. Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part, but when perfection comes, the imperfect disappears. When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put childish ways behind me. Now we see but a poor reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

## ○ Verses On Faith

- John 14:6 “Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”
- John 14:12 “I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.”
- Ephesians 2:8-9 “For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.”
- Galatians 2:20 “I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.”
