Family Philosophy

Mandatory Parents Meeting

Important information about the course(s) your student will be taking will be presented at the **mandatory parent/teacher's meeting** on **July 24, 2017**, from 10:00 – 12 at Lakeview Baptist Church. You will have an opportunity to meet each teacher and hear her give an overview of the course she is teaching. You will also have an opportunity to ask questions. Because this information is so important to your student's success in his/her class, one parent is required to attend. Students may come, but it is not required.

Class Dates

1st semester classes begin August 13, 2018, and end December 10, 2018 2nd semester classes begin January 7, 2019, and end May 6, 2019

Costs

- *Textbook:* Each student is responsible for purchasing the textbook(s) recommended by the teacher.
- Lab fees: \$15 for General Science, payable by Aug. 14 or with registration. Make check to Lakeview/JrHigh.
- *Registration fee:* EARLY BIRD of \$25 per family if paid by June 21st.

Regular fee of \$50 per family if paid after June 21st.

Checks for registration should be made out to Lakeview/JrHigh.

• **Tuition:** Tuition varies depending on the number of hours a class meets. Please see the registration form to determine the tuition rate for each class.

Tuition checks are <u>written to the individual teacher</u>, but <u>must be turned in with registration</u> paperwork.

- Step 1: Print and complete THREE forms: registration form, the parental agreement form, and the liability form (which must be notarized).
- Step 2: Write tuition checks to each teacher as listed on the registration form.
- Step 3: Write registration check to Lakeview/JrHigh.
