Dear Lakeview Family,

The ninth chapter of Paul's letter to the Romans is one of the most difficult to understand in all the Word of God. There we read, "Rebekah's children had one and the same father, our father Isaac. Yet, before the twins were born or had done anything good or bad – in order that God's purpose in election might stand, not by works but by him who calls – she was told 'The older will serve the younger.' Just as it is written 'Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated.'" (v. 10-13)

As one who will stand before the Lord someday to give an account of my life and ministry, I tremble in fear that I might read too much into this text or that likewise I might neglect to understand and proclaim the full implication taught therein. Pray for me as I prepare this week to preach to you this Sunday morning, February 16, from Romans 9:6-33 on "The Sovereignty of God in Salvation."

On Sunday evening I will preach on "The Cry of Separation" from Mark 15:34 where Jesus cried out to his Father, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" We will observe the Lord's Supper on Sunday evening.


