

### SUNDAY SCHOOL RECAP

Our first week back on campus went very smoothly. We anticipated about 25% of our pre-Covid adult attendance and we were very close to those numbers. Our adult rooms were filled to 50% capacity only and that was with 6 feet distancing between chairs.

Here is the breakdown of attendance on campus:

- Preschool: 45
- Children: 52
- Youth: 39
- College: 190
- Adults: 93
- Admin Officers: 3
- Total on campus— 422

The five adult classes are temporary classes that anyone can attend. They are taught by Robert Maddox, Bro. Hal, Mike Melvin, myself (Bro. Cliff) and Omar Ibanez (Spanish-speaking class). Even if you attend one of these classes, you will remain in your regular class for ministry and shepherding purposes. We continue to offer most of our other classes via zoom and have a much larger attendance with them. I am so thankful to all of our teachers for their continued ministry during these challenging days. We also want to affirm everyone's personal decision whether to participate via zoom or attend on campus. We will continue to monitor attendance and the readiness of other teachers/classes to come back as they are ready. I am hopeful that we can add more classes in the near future.
