Dear Lakeview Family,

It feels like my family just arrived in Auburn, yet we just completed our first month here. We have been moved so deeply by your kindness and are so very grateful for your intentional concern to help make our transition from Kentucky as seamless as possible.

Another blessing for me has been that I have been able to sit under Brother Al's powerful preaching for the last three weeks. It has refreshed my soul. But now I will be back in the saddle the next three Sunday mornings as we finish up our series on "Jesus Christ: The Glory of God Revealed."

This Sunday, July 25, I will be preaching from 1 Timothy 3:14-16 on "Jesus Christ: The Mystery of Godliness." Please pray for me that as I study the text, where I am ignorant, the LORD will teach me; where I am wrong, the LORD will correct me; and where I am right, the LORD will confirm me in my understanding of the truth of the text.

One last thing I would ask that you pray for: beginning next Sunday evening, outside the series Brother Al and I are preaching, I will begin preaching a series that will take me through November where I will take various well-known Old Testament texts and show how they point us to Jesus. This series will be preparation for our study in the Gospel of John that we will begin in Advent Season. As Jesus himself said of the Old Testament Scriptures, as written in the Gospel of John, "it is they that bear witness about me" (John 5:39). This Sunday evening, we will consider Exodus 3 and what Jesus himself described as "the passage about the bush" (Luke 20:37).

Thank you ahead of time for your prayers. One of our staff members shared at a staff meeting this week that one of the great blessings of being a staff member at Lakeview and, for that matter, preaching at Lakeview is that you pray for us. I am so grateful that the LORD has allowed my family and me to be a part of a praying church. We are so very thankful for you.
