



Dear Lakeview Family,

The Lord Jesus said, "I will build my church" (Matthew 16:18). Speaking of the growth of the church, Paul the apostle wrote, "I planted the (gospel) seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow" (1 Corinthians 3:6). Clearly, the life and health of the church is a matter of highest priority to the Lord Jesus. The church exists to glorify God by proclaiming the gospel of saving grace to all the nations. Many years ago as a church, we adopted the following statement as our defining northstar: We believe that God's purpose for Lakeview Baptist Church is to love the Lord God and to express that love by making, nurturing and equipping disciples of Jesus Christ in Auburn and throughout the world.

Every year since 1980, at the beginning of the school year, I have preached on the state of Lakeview Baptist Church. I will do so for the final time this Sunday morning, August 22. For many years, I used a metric of attendance, financial giving and baptisms to measure the health of our Lakeview faith family. While these matters are not unimportant, some years ago I came to the conclusion that church health cannot always be measured by the above criteria.

Having served as a pastor for more than fifty years, I have given my entire adult life to the church. I have thought long and hard about how to measure the health of a church. As a result, I have developed five axioms of a healthy church. Those axioms are:

- 1. In a healthy church, God's people love God; therefore, they worship him passionately.
- 2. In a healthy church, God's people love God's Word; therefore, they obey its precepts wholeheartedly.
- 3. In a healthy church, God's people love one another; therefore, they live together harmoniously.
- 4. In a healthy church, God's people love the lost; therefore, they proclaim the gospel faithfully.
- 5. In a healthy church, God's people love the nations; therefore, they go to all the earth fearlessly.

I will use these five axioms plus the Lakeview Church Covenant as the basis of my State of Lakeview Baptist Church message on Sunday morning. I look forward to sharing with you my perspective on the life and health of Lakeview.

2 PETER: GODLY LIVING IN THE LAST DAYS

On Sunday evenings, we are journeying through the Second Letter of Peter. This Sunday, at the 6:00 PM worship hour, I will be preaching from 2 Peter 1:5-11 on "A Know So Salvation." 


HELP WANTED FOREIGN MISSIONS LOCALLY

With the now current and recent COVID-19 situation, foreign mission trips have been almost impossible lately. I met recently with local groups that minister to international AU students and learned that quite a few international students have been accepted at AU and have already obtained the necessary Visa and permission to come to Auburn. Students are not the only people we are able to minister to through English lessons. There are many, many nationalities here that would love the opportunity to learn English. This increases their ability to live and work more easily here and also to learn what it means to follow Jesus.

Maybe God is calling you to do "At Home Foreign Missions." Lakeview's Conversational English classes will begin again on this Wednesday and we need teachers, co-teachers, children's workers and other support personnel to make this opportunity possible. Classes will be taught here on Lakeview's campus. We will also begin a new program in which a teacher/mentor and the prospective student will meet one-on-one once per week for one hour at the place they choose. The textbook for this new program is the Bible! What a great opportunity to share the love of Jesus with our international friends and hopefully see them accept Jesus as their personal Savior.

MEN AND WOMEN'S THEOLOGY GROUPS


