Mission:

Our mission is to partner with families to assist you as you home school your children. It is our desire to create a warm, loving environment with experienced, Godly teachers. We accomplish this mission by providing instructors who create lesson plans, assign homework, plan in-class activities and provide instruction in the hours each week when the class meets. Students are assigned the equivalent of a week’s homework to complete, and parents must ensure that students complete the given assignments. L.E.E.P. classes stress importance of attendance, completing assignments on time, following directions in a classroom setting, oral presentations, and other classroom skills that prepare them for Junior High and beyond.

Mandatory Orientation Meeting:

L.E.E.P. will have a mandatory meeting on Thursday, February 17, 2022 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at Lakeview Baptist Church in the Youth Center. This is an information meeting for the 2022-2023 school year. At least one parent must attend this meeting in order to register for classes. If you cannot attend, you will need to contact the L.E.E.P. coordinator (Anne Ingram, leepatlakeview@outlook.com, 334-728-8907) and schedule a meeting with her (\$10 fee) before you can register. You will receive registration packets at this meeting, but registration will not be open at that time. Some of the teachers will be there and they will be more than happy to answer your questions about the different courses offered by L.E.E.P.

Important Dates:

- Mandatory Orientation Meeting: Thursday, February 17 at 6:30 pm (Lakeview Youth Center).
- Registration opens for **CURRENT** L.E.E.P. families on Monday, February 28 & March 1, 2022 from 9-11 am.
- Registration opens for **Lakeview members** on Monday, March 14, 2022 from 9-11 am.
- Registration opens for **general public** on Monday, March 21, 2022 from 9-11 am.
- Fall Semester: Classes begin August 8, 2022 and end November 15, 2022.
- Spring Semester: Classes begin January 9, 2023 and end May 2, 2023.
- Field Day is Tuesday, May 9, 2023.

Costs:

- **Tuition cost** for the year is as follows:

1 hour class	\$170
1.5 hour class	\$260
2 hour class	\$340
3 hour class	\$510

- **Payment Options:**

- Option 1: Full registration paid at time of registration and full-year tuition paid at the time of registration (tuition checks held until May 1st).
- Option 2: Full registration fee paid at time of registration and two half-year payments of tuition (tuition checks held until May 1 for first semester and August 1 for second semester).

- **Textbook:** Each student is responsible for purchasing the textbooks recommended by the teachers.
- **Class Fees:** Art, History, Science (and possibly, Language) classes all require fees for lab and/or supplies. Fees are \$40 per year, per child (\$20 per semester). Fees are given directly to the teacher. The teacher(s) will be in contact with you regarding fees sometimes before school starts. Please do not write fees into registration or tuition checks.
- **Registration Fee:** The registration fee is \$50 per family for the first child and \$15 for each additional child. The registration fee is due at the time of registration. There will be a late fee of \$25 (total \$75 for one child) after May 1, 2022. Checks for registration fees, which are non-refundable, are to be made out to Lakeview Baptist Church/L.E.E.P.
- **Placement Test Fee:** If your child is new to Language classes, he or she will need to meet with the teacher to assess language placement. This fee is \$20.
- **Tuition:** Tuition checks are **written to the individual teacher** but must be turned in to coordinator (Anne Ingram) with registration paperwork. Tuition is non-refundable. For price of class, see registration form.
- **Commitment:** **Classes are a one-year commitment, not just one semester.** Paying by semester is a courtesy, but registration for classes is for both semesters.

How to Register:

- Step 1: Attend mandatory meeting on February 17, 2022 in the Youth Center at 6:30 pm.
- Step 2: Print and complete: Registration form, Activity form (requires notary) and Parental Agreement form.
- Step 3: Write tuition checks to each teacher as listed on the website. Tuition is non-refundable.
- Step 4: Write registration check to L.E.E.P. / Lakeview Baptist Church. Fees are non-refundable.

Checks written to each individual teacher and checks written to Lakeview Baptist Church for registration are due with all registration forms. **Registration is not complete until all completed forms and fees/tuition is/are received.**

No Refund Policy:

Why is a non-refundable policy necessary? Our classes are based on a co-op model. Parents share their specific course needs, and we contract with instructors to teach them. When registering, you contract with L.E.E.P., the instructors, and the other parents to participate in the course. Refunding tuition in cases of voluntary withdrawal weakens course quality, undermines our ability to recruit and retain instructors, and can result in class cancellations. Exceptions to this policy are made only in cases of hardship or extenuating circumstances beyond a family's control. In this situation, please contact Anne Ingram, L.E.E.P.
