Lakeview Preschool Adventures Statement

Lakeview Preschool Adventures exists as a ministry and under the authority of Lakeview Baptist Church. Therefore, we function and teach in accordance with all adopted statements of faith, including the Baptist Faith and Message, the Nashville Statement, the Manhattan Declaration, the Chicago Statement, and the Danvers Statement (all listed are on our website or available in the church office for review).

We will teach Biblical family values including that a marriage union is between one man and one woman. We will only recognize a child's sex and enroll a student according to the God given biological sex that he or she is categorized at birth.

Enrollment and Withdrawal Policy

Enrollment

Enrollment for returning students begins the last full week in January. Enrollment for new families begins the next week. Children will be put into classes according to their age as of September 1. LPA will follow this policy without exception.

In order to be registered, you must turn in your registration form with the registration fee. This fee is non-refundable.

Withdrawal Policy

We understand that it may be necessary to withdraw your child during the school year. We require a 30-day notice to withdraw your child. For example, if you withdraw your child at the end of November you will also need to pay December tuition. Lakeview Preschool Adventures is self-funded, independent from Lakeview Baptist Church. Our budget is based on the number children we have enrolled in our program. Again, we understand that things happen throughout the year that may cause you to need to withdraw; however, that does create a hardship for us if we are not able to fill the spot left open.

If you are planning to be out of town for an extended amount of time and you want your child to return to preschool when you return, you must pay tuition for the months that you are not at preschool. You can withdraw your child (with 30-day notice) and re-register if there is space available. You are not guaranteed a spot in the same class.
