



Dear Lakeview Family,

On January 23rd, a former church member of mine, who is now a new pastor in Minneapolis, texted me and asked me, "Is it normal for the lead pastor to send a thank you letter with the giving statements?" I responded, "I am not aware of that being done. After all, they are not giving to you or because of you. They are giving to the Lord. With that said, it could be done in a way that does not look self-serving. Something like, 'I thank the Lord that I have the privilege to pastor a congregation with so many sacrificial givers. The gospel pattern is grace comes down, gratitude goes up, and generosity flows out-for the Lord's glory.' You are a people who understand this and I am grateful to the Lord for you."

As I texted that response to my brother pastor, it did not occur to me that I would be using that very response just two weeks later in my Pastor's Pen. Indeed, as we heard the recent reports on the 2023 giving, I was amazed at God's goodness on our Lakeview family as evidenced in part by the fact that his grace has "overflowed in a wealth of generosity" from you (2 Corinthians 8:2).

For those of you who were not at our monthly business meeting, last year you gave a Lakeview record of \$3,744,119 to the work of the Lord. That is \$224,119 over the 2023 budget. Not only that, you have given thus far \$275,043.30 to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering (LMCO). That will be deeply impactful for the International Mission Board (IMB) in its goal to reach the nations with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Indeed, I can say, I am so very grateful for you. You give, because God's grace has taken hold in your affections and will. In other words, you give because you love. I have known that about you since Heather and I first came to Lakeview in 1999 when I served as an intern.

That said, maybe the Lord is leading you to give more to the LMCO. Or maybe, you have not yet given and you desire to give. This next Sunday, February 11, will be the last Sunday we will be taking up the LMCO. I would love to see us get to \$300,000 as a church. What a blessing that would be for our IMB.

Thank you for the privilege of being able to pastor such an exemplary church.


