Did you know that North America currently has 371 million people who speak 350 languages? Of far greater importance, did you know that it is estimated that 281 million of that 371 million people are not converted to Jesus Christ?

As a Lakeviewer, you may not have known these exact figures but you are certainly aware of the vast lostness on this continent and it troubles you. You have demonstrated that for decades as you have consistently given sacrificially to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering. Well, it is that time of year to begin praying about what the Lord might have you give to this strategic offering.

For those new to Southern Baptist life, the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering (AAEO) began in 1895 by the Woman's Missionary Union (WMU) to benefit the work of the Home Mission Board (now called the North American Mission Board). In 1934, it was named in honor of Annie Armstrong, who was a strong advocate for missions and WMU's first national executive leader.

Besides praying for and going on missions trips, the AAEO is the primary way we support mission efforts in North America. In fact, the AAEO provides 50% of the North American Mission Board budget. One hundred percent of gifts given to AAEO are used to support more than 2,900 missionaries serving across the United States, Canada, Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, Guam, and American Samoa. Two of those missionaries are Lakeviewers themselves, Savannah Hutto and Bo Smith.

We all know that as much as we would like our politicians to serve with character, integrity, and righteousness, our greatest need in this country is healthy churches and more of them! Giving to this offering is a strategic way to steward your hard-earned resources toward that end. Of course, you already know this and for that I am grateful.
