Dear Lakeview Family,

I want to plug a couple of crucial ministries this week and give you some important dates for your calendar. First, on Saturday, October 5th at Town Creek Park, Mercy Medical Ministry is having a “Fun Run” to raise financial support for their ministry. There will be a 5K, a 10K or a one-mile option. To register, go to [mercymedicalministry.org/run](https://mercymedicalministry.org/run). If you do not know about Mercy Medical Ministry, it is a ministry that shares the hope of Jesus Christ by offering low to no-cost outpatient medical services to those without health insurance, addressing not only patients' physical needs, but also attending to their spiritual and emotional needs.

Second, the “Super Stars” Enrichment Day classes are starting back up on Friday, September 6th, and every Friday (following Lakeview's and the Auburn City Schools' schedule) from 9:00 AM–1:00 PM. Last year's class worshiped, learned, exercised, served, and fellowshiped together, both at the church and out in the community. They learned to play hand bells, sharpened/replaced pencils in the sanctuary, and several other interesting things. This benefits both the Super Stars themselves, but also their parents. For the program to work, more volunteers are needed.

Speaking of volunteers for the “Super Stars,” they are also in need of helpers during Sunday School every Sunday, and during the morning service every Sunday. Of course, the more volunteers they have, the larger the rotation will be. Maybe some Sunday School classes could help form a rotation among their members. Volunteering to serve in this area would be a great blessing to so many families who have special needs image bearers in their home. I can assure you, it is more blessed to give than to receive (Acts 20:35).
