Please bring your completed forms and all tuition, registration, supply, and lab fees. The MANDATORY Information meeting (yellow) will be in the Fellowship Hall at Lakeview. Registration (all dates in green) will be in the Children's Department at Lakeview.

### **Mission:**

Our mission is to partner with families to assist you as you home school your children. It is our desire to create a warm, loving environment with experienced, Godly teachers. We accomplish this mission by providing instructors who create lesson plans, assign homework, plan in-class activities and provide instruction in the hours each week when the class meets. Students are assigned the equivalent of a week’s homework to complete, and parents must ensure that students complete the given assignments. L.E.E.P. classes stress importance of attendance, completing assignments on time, following directions in a classroom setting, oral presentations, and other classroom skills that prepare them for Junior High and beyond.

### **Mandatory Orientation Meeting:**

L.E.E.P. will have a mandatory meeting on Tuesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at Lakeview Baptist Church in the Fellowship Hall. This is an informational meeting for the 2025-2026 school year. At least one parent must attend this meeting in order to register for classes. There will be an introduction to the program, a summary of the fees and a review of the rules imposed by L.E.E.P. and by the church. Each teacher will go over class descriptions and expectations for the class (an overview). If you cannot attend, you will need to contact the L.E.E.P. coordinator (Anne Ingram, [leopatlakeview@outlook.com](mailto:leopatlakeview@outlook.com)), and schedule an individual meeting (\$10 fee) before you can register. Please remember – ALL REGISTRATION MUST BE COMPLETED IN PERSON – NO MAIL-IN FORMS.

### **Important Dates:**

- Mandatory Orientation Meeting: Tuesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 6:30 pm (Lakeview Fellowship Hall).
- Registration opens for **CURRENT** L.E.E.P. families and Lakeview members on Monday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- Registration opens for **general public** on Monday, March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025.
- After April 8th, registration fees increase by \$25. Please contact Anne Ingram to register your child.
- Fall Semester: Classes begin August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025, and end November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (14 Weeks).
- Spring Semester: Classes begin January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and end April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026 (14 Weeks).
- Field Day is Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

## Costs:

- **Tuition cost** for the year is as follows:

<b>1 hour class</b>	<b>\$170</b>
<b>1.5 hour class</b>	<b>\$260</b>
<b>2 hour class</b>	<b>\$340</b>
<b>2.5 hour class</b>	<b>\$425</b>
- **Tuition:** Checks for tuition and supply/lab fees are **written to the individual teacher(s)** but must be turned in with registration forms. One check per teacher/per class should be written for the total amount (tuition and lab/supply fees). Nothing is given directly to the teacher. Tuition and fees are non-refundable. For price of classes, see registration form. For example: Abbie Carter is teaching Language 3-4 (2-hour class). Tuition is \$340 and the supply fee is \$25. Abbie is also teaching Sea Creatures (1.5 hour class). Tuition is \$260 and the lab fee is \$50. If your child is taking both classes, you would write one check to Abbie Carter for \$365 (Language) and another check to her for \$310 (Sea Creatures).
- **Supply Fees:**
  - For Art, History and Science, there is a \$50 supply fee per student, per year.
  - For Spanish class, there is a \$30 supply fee per student, per year.
  - For Language classes, there is a \$25 supply fee per student per year.
  - For P.E., there is a \$5 supply fee per student per year.
- **Registration Fee:** The enrollment fee is \$105 per student. Included in this fee is \$50 for registration, \$25 administration fee, and \$30 per student for the cost of field day activities. The enrollment fee is due at the time of registration. After April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025 enrollment increases to \$130 per student. **Checks for enrollment fees, which are non-refundable, are to be made out to Lakeview Baptist Church/L.E.E.P.**
- **Textbook:** Each student is responsible for purchasing the textbooks recommended by the teachers.
- **Full Payment** is due for the full year (tuition, supply fees, registration fees) at the time of registration. Checks for enrollment will be deposited during the registration period. All tuition checks written to teachers will be given to the teachers on April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025 and are non-refundable. They will not be cashed before that date. Checks are preferred, but if paying by cash, there are specific requirements – please see Anne Ingram.
- **Commitment:** **Classes are a one-year commitment, not just one semester. Once checks and forms are accepted by the L.E.E.P. program, they are non-refundable.**

## How to Register:

- Step 1: Attend mandatory meeting on March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 in the Lakeview Fellowship Hall at 6:30 pm.
- Step 2: Print and complete: Registration form, Ministry Participation form\* and Parental Agreement form. If the student(s) already has a Ministry Participation form on file with Lakeview, it is not required to complete another for this year.
- Step 3: Write tuition/supply check(s) to each teacher as outlined above. Tuition is non-refundable.
- Step 4: Write enrollment check to L.E.E.P. / Lakeview Baptist Church. Fees are non-refundable.

Checks written to each individual teacher and checks written to Lakeview Baptist Church for enrollment are due with all registration forms. **Registration is not complete until all completed forms and fees/tuition is/are received.**

## No Refund Policy:

Why is a non-refundable policy necessary? Our classes are based on a co-op model. Parents sign up for courses, and we contract with instructors to teach them. When registering, you contract with L.E.E.P., the instructors, and the other parents to participate in the course. Refunding tuition in cases of voluntary withdrawal weakens course quality, undermines our ability to recruit and retain instructors, and can result in class cancellations. Exceptions to this policy are made only in cases of hardship or extenuating circumstances beyond a family's control. In this situation, please contact Anne Ingram, L.E.E.P.
