SENIOR GIRLS RETREAT CALLAWAY GARDENS



Steve has been a Washington state resident for most of his life. After transferring from the University of Colorado, Steve attended Pacific Lutheran University where he was honored on football All-American teams for three of his four years. He is a member of his college Athletic Hall of Fame and the Tacoma Pierce County Athletic Hall of Fame. Steve has been featured in a number of publications, including Decision Magazine.

As the Executive Director of the Northwest Network Foundation, Steve Ridgway "mentors emerging and existing leaders." He travels extensively and has spoken to groups as large as 60,000, but his greater focus is "the One." Over the course of his life, he has run a political campaign and taught in the public school system. Steve has been the chaplain of a major college football program, traveled in lands ravaged by war and famine, and led a major non-profit as their (interim) President and CEO (formerly, Open Doors USA). Steve is a connector of people, and his greatest passion is seeing people connect to Jesus.

Steve believes that the message of Jesus is an unsafe message full of hope and promise for unsafe places. Our next meeting will be Thursday, May 8th, 2025.
