



Dear Lakeview Family,

I am excited to make you aware of upcoming foster care training classes in Auburn through Alabama Baptist Children's Home (ABCH). Classes start on September 9th and will meet for 10 consecutive weeks (5:30-8:30). Childcare will be provided. Every year, 6,000 children in Alabama are in the foster care system, and, unfortunately, there are fewer than 2,400 total foster homes (AL DHR). In other words, there is a deep need for foster care parents. As Martin Luther quipped, 'God does not need our good works; but our neighbor does' and there are some 6,000 neighbors in Alabama, alone, who need care.

If you remember, I preached 2 Samuel 9 on Sanctity of Human Life where King David brought Mephibosheth to eat at the king's table, even though Mephibosheth, who was lame in both his feet, had nothing to offer the king (2 Samuel 9:11-13). It was David showing "the kindness of God to him" (9:7).

In one sense, this text is a **picture** of what the greater David, our Lord Jesus Christ, does for us who has nothing to offer him. But I would also submit that for those of us who have been brought to that table by "the kindness of God," it is more than a picture. It should serve as a **pattern** to follow.

Indeed, one evidence we have **experienced** the kindness of God is that we **exude** the kindness of God. Now, given our finitude, no one here can even skim the surface of the needs out there, but you can be a role player and foster care would be a highly, strategic role.

Let me offer you one family in our church who has taken up that challenge, Nathan and Anna Clair Moore. They have been fostering for over two years now and are currently on children number four and five. Recently, the Moores transferred a baby girl who had been in their care for four months to a new home. When they arrived, they walked into the home and were greeted by a couple in their upper 60s. The man was a hospital chaplain and a pastor at a small church in Theodore. Nathan saw on the wall 18-picture frames, each showing a different foster child who had been in that home. The woman was rocking baby number 19 in her lap, and Nathan was holding the baby who would be number 20 after they left. The Moores were stunned by these photos and asked the lady, "These are a lot of kids! How long have you been fostering?" She replied, "About seven years." This couple STARTED fostering little babies in their 60s!

Fostering is not for everyone, but in a church the size of Lakeview, there has to be others called to this ministry who just do not know it yet. If a family like the Moores, with three kids who were 6 years old and under when they started, AND empty-nesters who did not start until their 60s, are both doing this, surely there are other families at Lakeview who God might be calling but need some information, encouragement, or support in order to take the first step.

Furthermore, there are so many other opportunities to serve existing foster families, like getting background checks to be an "approved" babysitter, to being a transporter, to giving to ABCH, etc.

Here are some benefits of investing in the Mephibosheths of this world: (1) Foremost, we demonstrate our gratitude for grace by being conduits of grace. That glorifies God. (2) It follows the example of the king who brought us to his table. (3) It is one of God's means of transforming the world. (4) You can learn the gospel better this way.
