Dear Lakeview Family,

I hope your fall is off to a joyful start. Over the next week or two, I will be offering offer ways you can minister in our community. Mercy Medical Clinic is a ministry that shares the hope of Jesus Christ by offering low to no-cost outpatient medical services to those without health insurance, while addressing not only patients' physical needs, but also attending to their spiritual and emotional needs.

The clinic has two specific manpower needs. For one, there is a need for student volunteers. At Mercy Medical, student volunteers serve as the initial point of contact for their clients. While many of their student volunteers are pursuing pre-health tracks, they welcome students from all majors. Mercy Medical desires a commitment of one to two four-hour shifts per week. I am positive it will be well worth the investment of a student's time.

There is also a need for spiritual encouragers who can show the love of Jesus and share the gospel with willing patients. Keep in mind, every new encourager is given the opportunity to go alongside more experienced encouragers until he or she feels comfortable sharing alone. Of course, training and training tools are also available to utilize as needed. Each encourager is screened carefully to ensure he or she is adequately prepared to spiritually engage each patient.

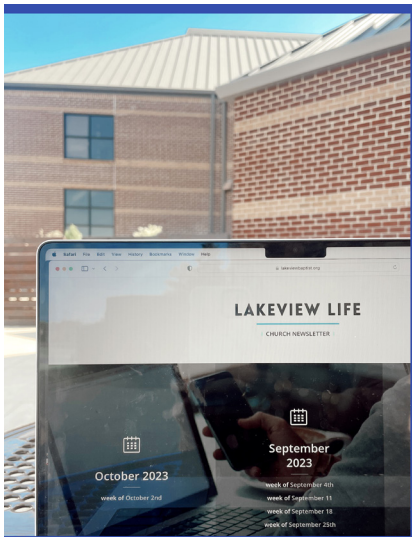
