Dear Lakeview Family,

Last week, I shared one way you can minister in our community is by serving at Mercy Medical. Today, I would like to offer another way. Volunteer at Women's Hope Medical Clinic.

Most of you know Women's Hope is a Christian ministry dedicated to meeting the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of those facing an unplanned pregnancy. This important ministry promotes the sanctity of human life and the benefits of healthy relationships and sexual integrity. In the New Heavens and Earth, there will be no need for this ministry, but until that day, especially in an age increasingly characterized as a culture of death and sexual license, Women's Hope is vital.

How can you help? First, there is a dire need for "parenting mentors" (volunteer to encourage a mother or father in their parenting journey) and "client advocates" (meet with clinic clients during their first visit, get to know them, and offer encouragement). To volunteer in either of these capacities, email allie@womenshope.org.

Another way to help Women's Hope is participating in their "Walk for Life + 5K" fundraiser on Saturday, November 8. You can register you and your family for the 5K or 1-Mile Walk.

To participate in the walk/run, click "Become a Fundraiser," creating a fundraising page. Then, click the "Donate" button, select "Team Lakeview." Ask your family and friends to sponsor you.
