Dear Lakeview Family,

We are now at the beginning of the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering (LMCO) season. For those of you that are new to the Southern Baptist world, the LMCO is an annual offering collected by Southern Baptists to support international missions. In 1918, the Women's Missionary Union officially named the offering in honor of Lottie Moon, a missionary to China, who urged churches to give sacrificially for the sake of Christ's name among the nations.

This offering is not to buy Christmas presents for missionaries as some have thought. Every dollar goes directly to the field. The offering helps free missionaries from the burden of fundraising and allows them to stay in the field 100% of the time. It brings tangible help through medical supplies, clean water, and most importantly, the message of the gospel.

In fact, on the field, \$10 provides one month of missionary language training. One hundred dollars provides supplies for a missionary to serve in a refugee camp for a week. Three hundred dollars provides a one-year license renewal for a missionary doctor and \$2500 provides one year of homeschool curriculum for missionary children. The need is more urgent than ever.

As you have been taught and have thoroughly believed for decades, the Great Commission is the mission of the church. As has been aptly asserted, "The mission of the church is to go into the world and make disciples by declaring the gospel of Jesus Christ in the power of the Spirit and gathering these disciples into churches, that they might worship and obey Jesus Christ now and in eternity to the glory of God the Father" (DeYoung and Gilbert, *What is the Mission of the Church?*).

Please pray about what God is leading you to give. I have all faith that the people of God at Lakeview will continue to sacrificially give to the LMCO so that the nations might be glad and sing for joy in Jesus Christ. Indeed, may God be gracious to Lakeview Baptist and bless us and make his face to shine upon us, that his way may be known on earth, his saving power among all nations (c.f. Ps 67:1-4).

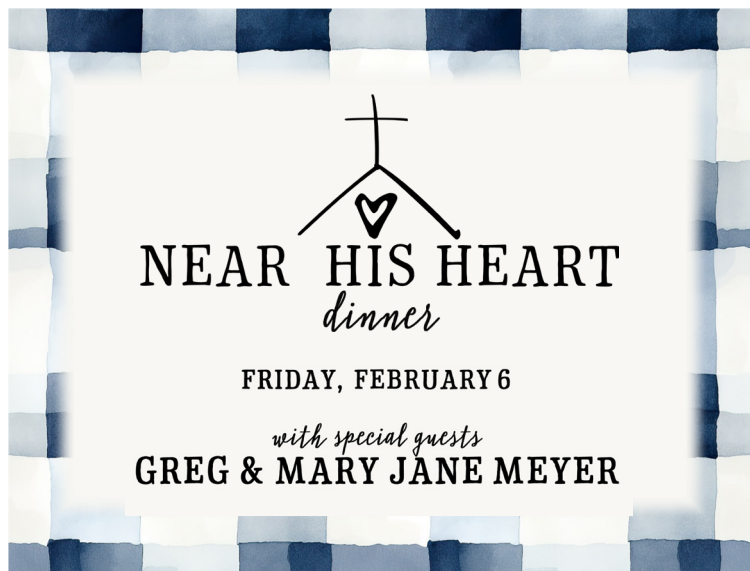

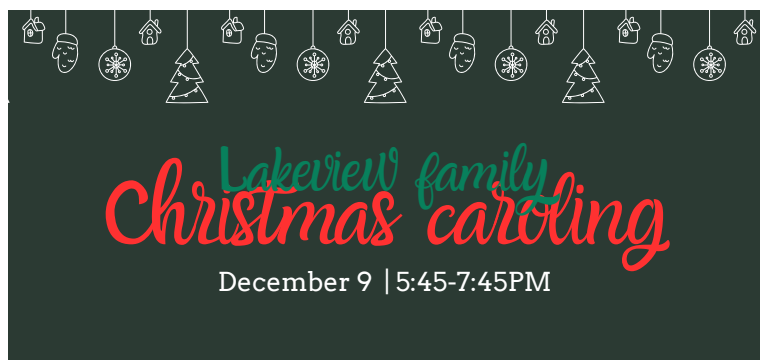
