The Client Care Specialist at Women's Hope Medical Clinic serves as a compassionate first point of contact for clients and community members, answering phone inquiries related to services, appointments, donations, and patient needs. This role is responsible for scheduling pregnancy tests and ultrasound appointments, sending appointment reminders, and clearly explaining clinic services in accordance with established procedures while maintaining strict client confidentiality. The Client Care Specialist greets clients upon arrival, administers and files intake paperwork, and meets with first-time patients to discuss their pregnancy situation, needs, and available support.
