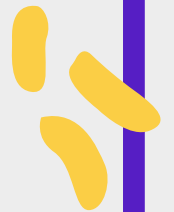
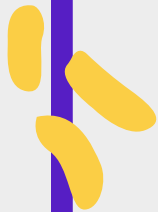

Dear Parents,

The purpose of our Scripture Memory plan is to help your child develop consistent habits with God's Word, which is living and active. We trust that the Holy Spirit will bring these verses back to their memory throughout their lives to enlighten their hearts to His truth.

By leading them to the Holy Scriptures, you are helping them understand Jesus' love, His redemptive plan, and the new life found in Him (Romans 10:17). We are so thankful for your faithfulness in teaching your children to treasure God's Word.

As 2 Timothy 3:14-17 reminds us, "But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of... from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus."

Our Sunday School teachers are eager to support the children in this program, and we encourage consistent parental involvement at home. Discussing each verse daily can serve as a meaningful time for family devotion and help your child apply Scripture to their daily life.

Please note that this program is designed to complement our standard Sunday School curriculum. To ensure a comfortable environment, no child will be asked to recite verses in front of a large group against their wishes. As your child progresses from first through sixth grade at Lakeview Baptist, they will receive a new Bible Memory plan tailored to their specific grade level.

To celebrate the children's diligence in storing up God's Word, we will host a Scripture Memory Banquet at the end of the year. This is a wonderful opportunity to recognize their hard work, regardless of how many verses they have memorized. But more importantly, our ultimate focus remains on the power of God's holy, sufficient, and authoritative Word. The true treasure for our children is the gift of God's Word in their hearts and minds! Let's go for it!



Who will take part? When will children recite verses?


All children are encouraged to participate. With their parents' help, children will memorize verses at home and recite them to their Sunday School teachers to earn bronze, silver, and gold medals. Teachers will provide additional details in class.

How long will my child(ren) have to memorize the verses?

The Scripture memory plan runs from May through March to coincide with Sunday School classroom advancement. Our booklet contains verses in the English Standard Version (ESV).

How will I know what my child(ren) has recited?

Each child will receive a grade-level booklet to track their progress. Parents and teachers should both keep a record of completed verses. If a replacement booklet is needed, please ask your child's teacher. Additionally, each classroom features a sticker chart to display student progress.



Q & A

Can children earn previously missed medals?

Absolutely! Children can earn medals for missed years. First, a child will need to complete the gold medal for their current grade, and then they may begin working on medals for previous grades.

How much of this do children have to learn?

Scripture memory is not required. We trust parents to know the best fit for their children and family during the different seasons of their lives and we honor and support your prayerful decision on what is right for your family. Our goal and prayer remain to come alongside families in shepherding children's hearts to Jesus.

And if my child does earn a medal, what then?

At the end of April, we will host a Children's Scripture Memory Banquet for every child who earns a medal and their family, corresponding to bronze, silver, or gold medals, respectively. Additionally, 6th-grade students who earn six gold medals will receive a 6 Year Medalist Plaque and their names will be added to the plaque in the children's reception area.

THE DISCIPLES ARMOR



□ Ephesians 6:10-18 |

(v. 10) "Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might.

(v. 11) Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.

(v. 12) For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

(v. 13) Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm.

(v. 14) Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness,

(v. 15) and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace.

(v. 16) In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one;

(v. 17) and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God,

(v. 18) praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints."
