Dear Lakeview Family,

As you have likely heard, on Wednesday, June 24th, two powerful earthquakes struck 39 seconds apart, measuring 7.2 and 7.5 on the Richter scale, along the coast of Venezuela. The quakes were some of the strongest to hit that nation in over a century and have brought with them significant devastation, with new assessments of the destruction continuing to be updated.

As of Monday afternoon, the death toll has risen to 1,450, but tens of thousands remain missing. Several of you have expressed a desire to help. Praise God for your burden and hearts.

Gratefully, our Southern Baptist Convention's own Send Relief exists for times like this. Our Send Relief is the global compassion ministry and disaster response organization of the Southern Baptist Convention. It serves to meet physical and spiritual needs in Jesus' name for the sake of Christ's glory and gospel.

Instead of acting independently, Send Relief equips and resources local churches to minister directly to their own communities and when you give to Send Relief, 100% of your gift is used for compassion ministry. Nothing is used for administrative costs. (www.sendrelief.org)

Of course, another way to help is to pray. Our Send Network has suggested some ways to pray:

- The injured and for families searching for loved ones.
- Protection over rescue workers as aftershocks continue.
- Venezuelan churches and believers as they serve their communities with compassion and the hope of Christ.

- The hope that many people would experience the love of Christ through the faithful presence of local churches.

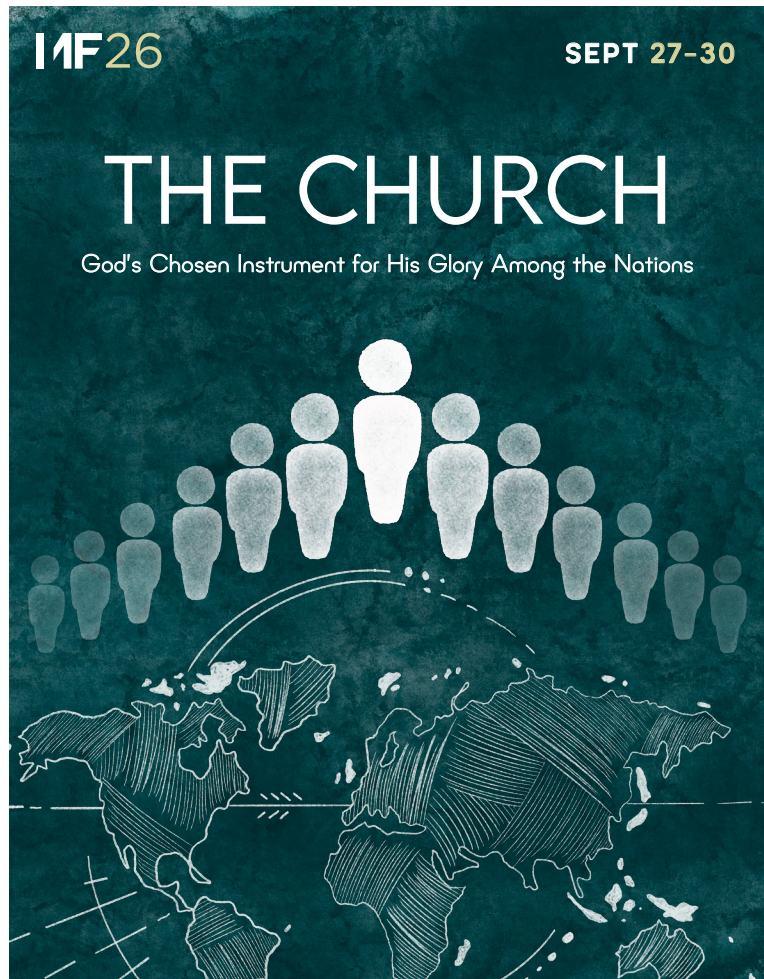
